### **HOUSING – SHERATON WAIKIKI, SHERATON PRINCESS KAIULANI, OR ROYAL HAWAIIAN**

Guest rooms may only be checked in by the guest whose name is on the reservation. The hotel does not allow other guests to pick up keys in a person's absence, regardless of military status. It is not acceptable for someone to present another person's ID in exchange for their guest room; this is a violation of hotel policy. The guest must be physically present with their ID to check in. The hotel will not release room keys to anyone whose name is not on the reservation.

Any special requests must be made through the hotel before the attendee's arrival and can only be made by the guest whose name is on the reservation. At check-in, a payment method (i.e., credit card) is required, and no key will be given to a registered guest if a method of payment is not established with the hotel at check-in.
